



Abstract Instructional Form

- 1 – Abstract must be written exclusively in good English, clearly showing the content to be presented
- 2 - The abstract must contain high-quality research material; the Scientific Committee reserves the right to accept or to refuse the submission
- 3 - The title has to be brief, short and describe the presentation, not to exceed 20 words.
- 4 - State specific objectives of the study.
- 5 - State the methods used.
- 6 - Summarize the results obtained and the conclusions reached.
- 7 - Standard abbreviations can be used. Special or unusual abbreviations are not recommended. If otherwise necessary, the latter should be placed in parenthesis after the first appearance of the full word, except for unit symbols. Numeral rather than words may be used to indicate numbers.
- 8 - The author's names have to be mentioned preceded by initials. Please underline the **Presenting Author** of the abstract.
- 10 - State institutional affiliations.
- 11 - Authors will be notified regarding acceptance or rejection by **August 17, 2025.**
- 12 - Feel free to add graphs and pictures.
- 13 - Case reports are accepted.
- 14 - Please limit your text to 350 words and the illustrations to 3.
- 15 - Ensure that the file's capacity is limited to a maximum size of 1 GB.
